Lecturers Inbound Program

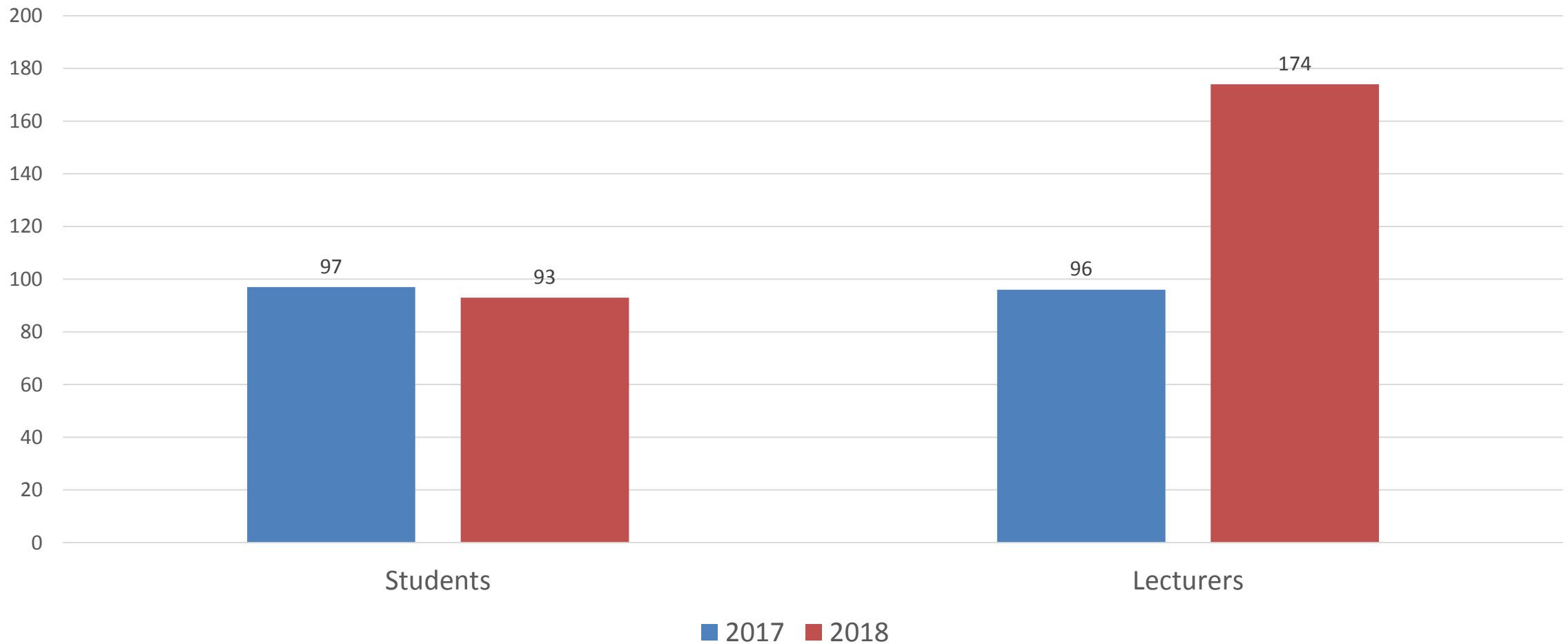
- Guest scholar, visiting scholar, visiting researcher

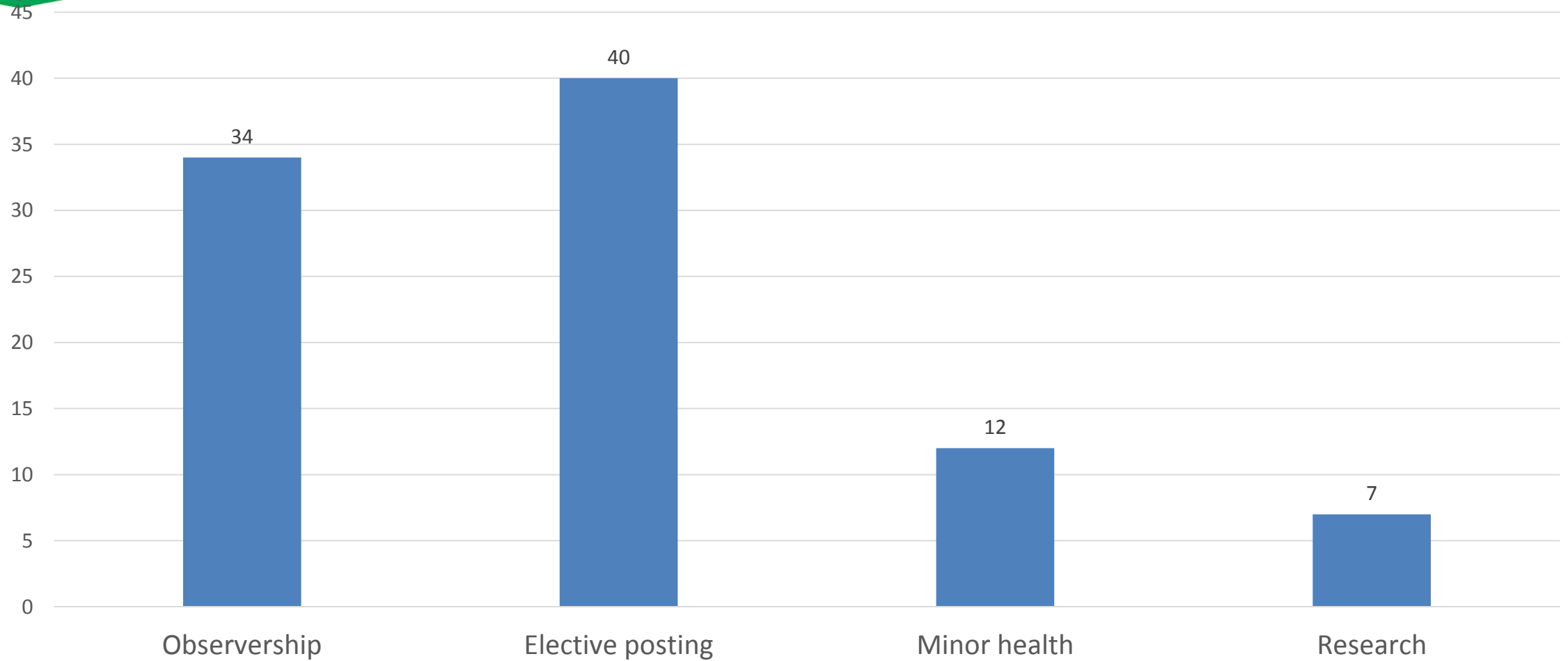

Staffs and students of FMUI who experience academic or cultural activities overseas

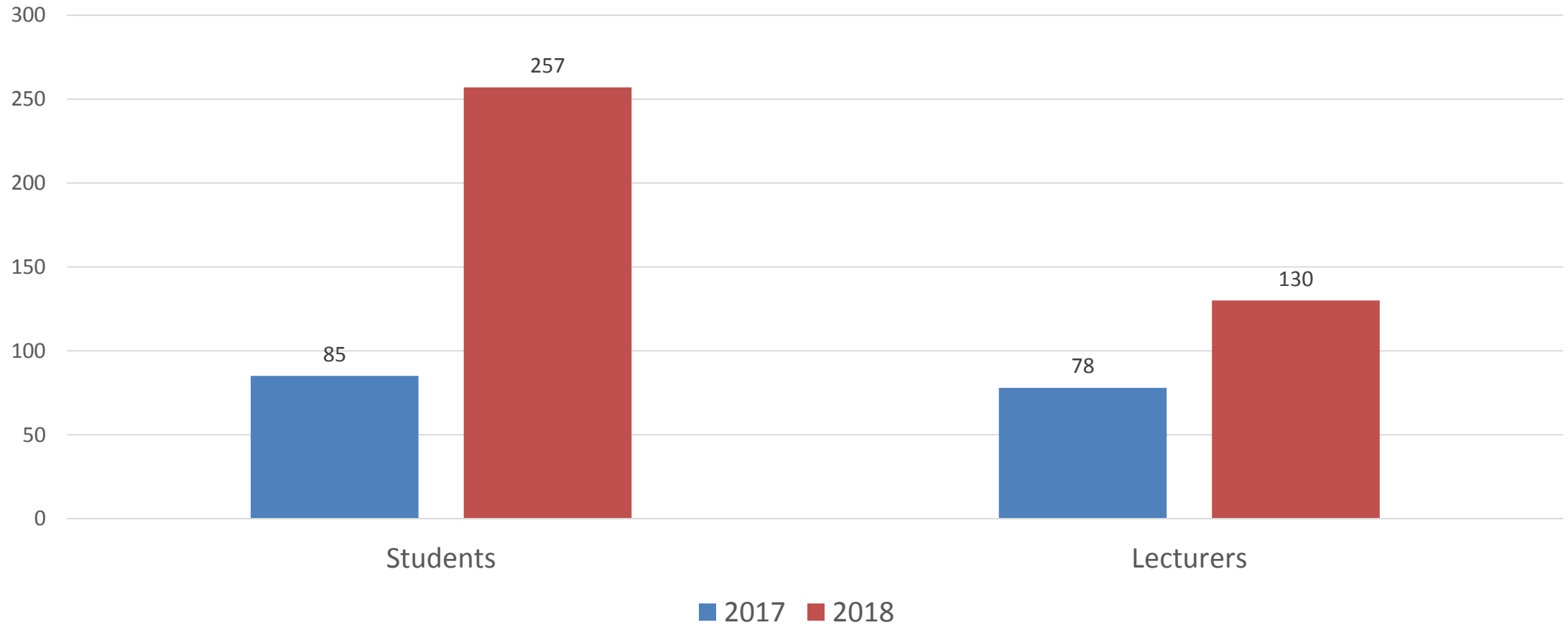
Lecturers Outbound Program

- Elective non-clinic program

- In elective program, medical students can choose **one module to enrich their knowledge** of a particular topic
- Elective non-clinic program held 4 times a year in **September, December, March, and May** for a month
- FMUI accepts exchange students to have academic activities and **transfer credit scheme**

Problems of Student Exchange Experienced

- Expensive

Kobe and NUS → give scholarship for selected students

LUMC → collaboration in financial between FMUI and LUMC

IFMSA provided free tuition fee and accommodation

Melbourne Univ, Monash, Newcastle → International class

- Unmatched **curriculum calendar** between universities

- Transfer credit

- Travel and health insurance → emergency rescue

- Aligning **exchange program's timeline** thus common credits for student exchange may easily be implemented – e.g. Summer program
