- 6-8 students per year



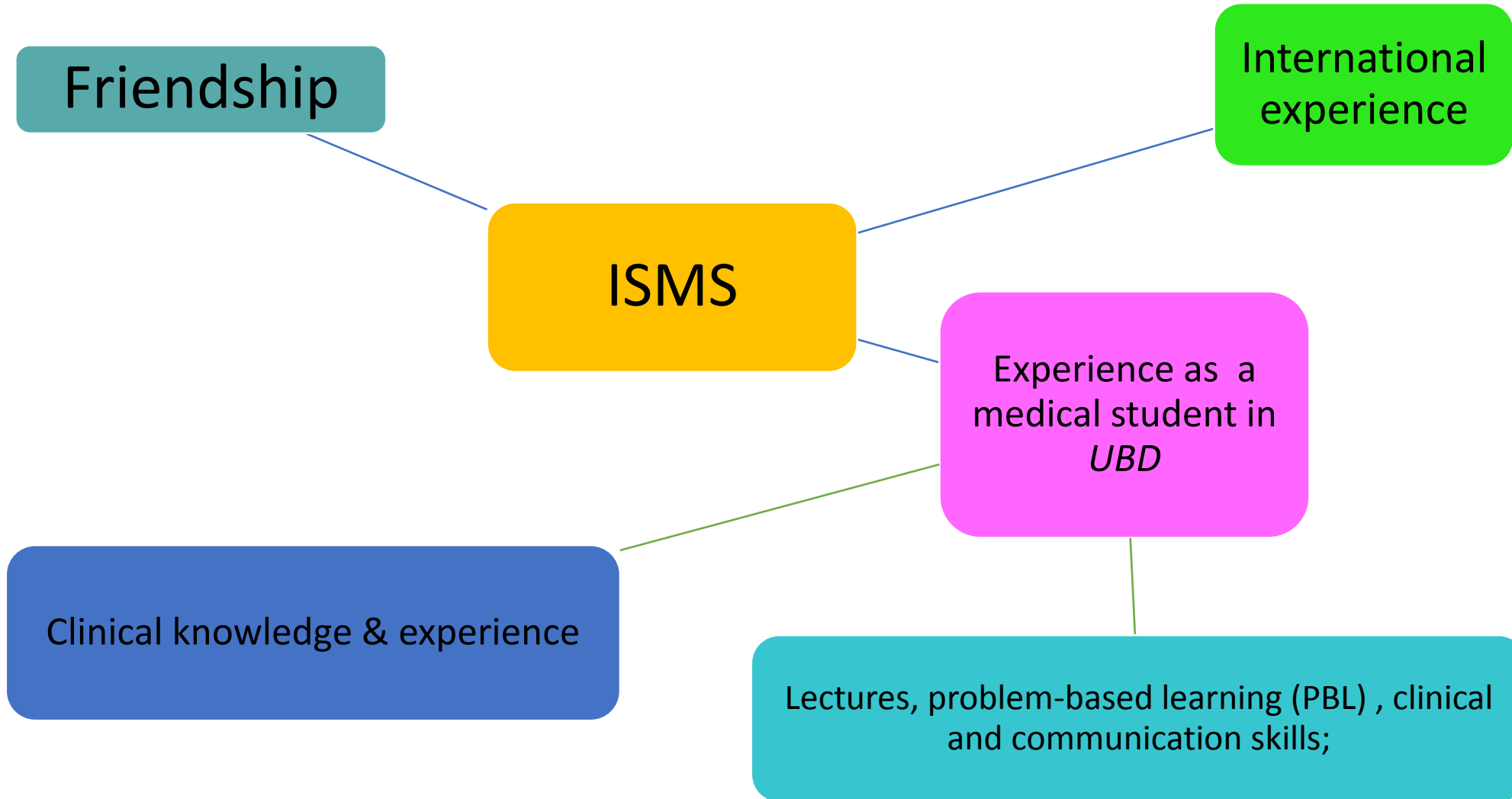
Objectives:

 - developing the society through cultivation of intellect and culture through collaborative activities.

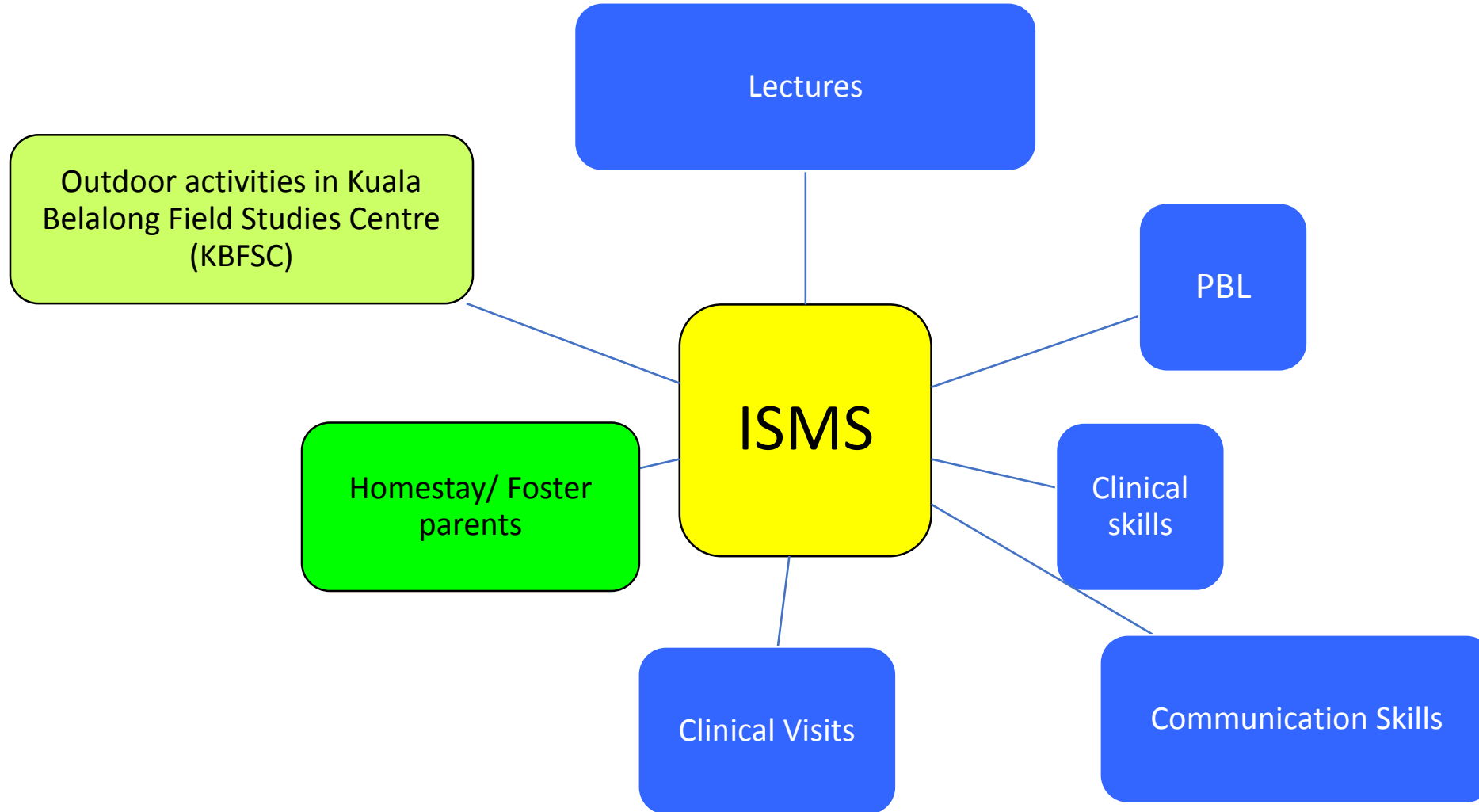
Benefits:
