- Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all.
- Strengthen the means of implementation and revitalise the Global Partnership for Sustainable Development.

Mission

Developing the Society Through Cultivation of Intellect and Culture Through Collaborative Activities

Objectives

Students participating in the programme will be able to:

- Experience life as a medical student in PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences through variety of academic activities i.e. lectures, Problem Based Learning (PBL), clinical and communication skills, large group sessions, and tutorials.
- Gain clinical knowledge and hands-on experience from clinical visits, placements and clinical skills sessions.
- Enhance English language proficiency and presentation skills.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

Problem Based Learning (PBL) & Tutorials

Problem Based Learning (PBL) is the main method of learning of Medicine in UBD. It allows students to explore PBL methods and enhance their communication and teamwork skills.

There will be two PBL cases covered with Dr Solachuddin on the case of Myocardial Infarction, on the 30th July and 5th August. Students are expected to equally and actively contribute to the group discussions and respectfully listen to others' points of view and ideas.

Personal and Professional Development (PPD)

This PPD session will be delivered by Dr Hanna on 31st July. She will review the concepts and the principles of basic and Islamic laws. She will also discuss the principles and theories of medical and biomedical ethics. This will be a joint session with the Year 2 Medicine and Dentistry students.

Lecture

The lecture by Dr Abdullahi on 31st July will give an overview of the PBL cases and cover the difficult concepts behind myocardial infarction, and the anatomy of heart and blood vessels. The lecture is aimed to supplement the PBL cases reviewed and to encourage students to learn and do research by themselves. This will be a joint session with the Year 2 Medicine students.

Clinical Visits

These clinical visits aim to expose the students to the clinical settings in Brunei Darussalam. Accompanied by Dr Faye, students will visit RIPAS hospital and other health centres in Bandar Seri Begawan. Students are required to be punctual, and are encouraged to talk to patients and staff and ask questions.

It is advised that students adhere to proper attire (wearing nametags) and regulations of the respective health centres. Dress code is smart: long sleeves and long trousers/long skirt for females.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

Communication and Clinical Skills (CCS)

Communication and Clinical Skills allows for students to practice interaction and communication skills with patients and other various clinical skills. During the CCS session on 2nd August with Dr Faye, students will be taught the clinical skills relevant to the PBL cases studied including cardiovascular examination.

First Aid Briefing & Demonstration

Students will be involved in a demonstration session with Cikgu Asnah on 29th July who will teach and demonstrate to them the basics of First Aid. She will begin the session with a brief introduction to medical and environmental emergencies. She will also teach the students the skills that are useful and can be life-saving in various medical emergencies such as injuries, sprains, and allergic reactions. Additionally, she will show the students the procedures to mitigate environmental emergencies, such as in a heatstroke or in the case of animal bites or poison. A major focus of the session will be the demonstration and practice of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) for unresponsive casualty.

Laboratory Demonstration & Genomics

Research at IHS

PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences host a range of research areas in the field of health sciences including biomedical sciences, health sciences education, nursing, pharmacy and public health. On the 1st August, Dr Lie and Dr Zen will demonstrate to the students some of the research projects that are being conducted at the faculty. They will also highlight the ongoing genomics research that are supported by our Biomedical Genomics Core (BGC) Laboratory.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

Written Assessment & Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE)

A short written assessment and an OSCE (practical) exam will be held on 6th August. These assessments aim to test the knowledge and skills that the students have acquired during the academic sessions of the programme. Briefing on these assessments will be delivered by Dr Faye on 22nd July.

Oral Presentation

Students are expected to present interesting aspects of their academic or cultural experience and important issues they have learned during the ISMS programme. The presentation will be held on 7th August and the members of the PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences will be invited to attend.

This session provides the students an opportunity to display their English proficiency and public communication skills.

Programme Feedback Session

This session will allow students to share their opinion or give suggestions for further improvement of the ISMS programme. This will be held on 7th August with Dr Liyana and Dr Hanisah.

Opening Ceremony

Royal Regalia Visit

The Royal Regalia Museum was opened in 1992 as part of the Sultan's silver jubilee celebrations. The museum houses priceless artifacts, including coronation furniture, jeweled costumes, extravagant gifts to the Sultan of Brunei and the coronation carriage, and exhibitions chronicling the life of His Majesty, the Sultan of Brunei.

Kampong Ayer Boat Ride

Kampong Ayer (the Water Village) is one of Bandar Seri Begawan's main tourist attractions. It is situated over the Brunei Bay and all the buildings are constructed on stilts above the river. Students will experience this national heritage by taking a boat or water taxi through the Brunei River, and visiting a stilt house. If you are lucky, you might catch a glimpse of the proboscis monkeys that are prominent along the mangroves!

Arts & Handicraft Centre

The Brunei Arts and Handicrafts Centre is a governmental centre that was established in 1975 and is coordinated by the Brunei Museum. Its role is to preserve Brunei traditional arts and crafts, and train local craftsmen and weavers. The centre displays and sells various types of handicraft products at the exhibition and sales gallery.

Balai Khazanah Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah

Balai Khazanah Islam Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah was officially established by His Majesty Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam in 2019. It is a centre for Islamic knowledge heritage that preserves precious historical artifacts through collection, exhibition, research, and dissemination of knowledge of Islam.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

Brunei Energy Hub Dermaga Diraja

Brunei Energy Hub Dermaga Diraja was established only last year, 2023. It is an interactive knowledge hub that enables visitors to explore what life in Brunei was like before the discovery of oil in 1929 through its multiple galleries. Students will have the opportunity to learn about the oil & gas industry today and the national strategies that are in place for a greener future with affordable and sustainable energy.

Ulu Temburong National Park

The Ulu Temburong National Park is located in the Temburong District, which contains a large part of the country's unspoiled jungle. On the 3rd August, students will have the chance to experience Brunei tropical beauty at the Ulu Temburong National Park. They will explore the forest via various activities including riding of the long boat ("Tamuai"), trekking of the canopy walkway, exploring the rainforest water streams and waterfall, and participating in water activities such as rafting, kayaking, and tubing (subject to weather and water conditions). The day will begin at 7 AM and finish at 4 PM, and breakfast and lunch will be provided at the Ulu Temburong National Park.

Students are advised to wear appropriate attire, and to bring insect repellent and a change of clothes.

Tasek Lama Hiking Activity

Hiking is a popular past time activity in Brunei. At Tasek Lama Recreational Park, students can hike through the greenery or have a peaceful walk to a small waterfall and a large reservoir.

Bandarku Ceria

Bandarku Ceria is a weekly event that occurs on Sundays in the capital of Brunei Darussalam — Bandar Seri Begawan. The aim of this event is to create a healthy lifestyle, strengthen family bonds, and enliven the capital's atmosphere. During the event, no cars are allowed in specific areas of the capital city. Everyone is encouraged to walk or cycle and participate in activities lined up under Bandarku Ceria.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

Learning Traditional Dances with BJFA-UBD

Chapter

There will be an afternoon of a Japanese dance session on the 31st July, hosted by the Brunei Japan Friendship Association (BJFA)-UBD student club. It will take place in the Dance Culture Club room, on the second floor of the Student Affairs Building. This will be an opportunity for a cultural exchange where IHS student buddies can learn from the BJFA-UBD club members and the Kagawa students. Everyone will learn the traditional Japanese dance called Souran Bushi (ソーラン節). They will also try the traditional dance style Yosakoi (the use of clappers) to the modern music of Sakase ya Sakase. A traditional fan dance performance choreographed to the song Aion no Uta will also be included in the activity. Everyone will have the opportunity to wear the traditional garment "Yukata".

UBD Wednesday Weekly Activity

UBD organises "Wednesday Weekly Activity" whereby members of the university are invited to attend physical exercises in the afternoon of Wednesdays such as tabata, zumba, hiking, and brisk walking around the campus. Subject to confirmation, students are expected to join the activity organised by UBD for the afternoon of 7th August.

Homestay

Homestay provides the students a chance to experience the social and cultural aspect of staying in a house of a Bruneian Family. Each student will be assigned a host family and will spend a night with them on the 26th July.

Exploring Tutong and Belait Districts

The students will have an opportunity to explore and sightsee other districts in Brunei - Tutong and Belait Districts - on the 27th of July with their IHS student buddies. During this visit trip, the students will observe some national landmarks including oilfields in Belait and [COMPLETE FOR TUTONG].

Closing Ceremony

The Closing Ceremony of the ISMS Programme will be held in the evening of 5th August. This ceremony serves as a farewell event for Kagawa students who participated in the ISMS programme. Attendees will be entertained with social and cultural performances by Kagawa students and IHS student buddies.
